

The A Child's World Board of Directors also play a crucial role in our organization by actively sharing in the organization's mission and objectives. They include parents of children in our programs as well as community members with varied backgrounds.

Some 2023 Key Achievements for A Child's World:

• We engaged our Educators in an Employee Engagement Survey which yielded favourable results. Information and suggestions obtained in the survey have been, and continues to be, a part of our planning sessions.

• We continue to work extremely hard to recruit and retain Educators in order to maintain ratios at our centres and to keep the doors open.

• We started the process and implementation for our responsibilities to comply with ONCA (The Ontario Not-for-Profit Corporations Act)

• For the very first time Educators participated in the Niagara Cares 2023 Early Learning and Child Care Conference.





2023 ACW PROGRAM UPDATES



As part of the QCCN Initiative Educators complete a Speech and Language Checklist yearly on each child enrolled in our centres. Last year the checklists were updated and so the ECCDC offered a virtual training session for all centre Educators to participate in. ACW Educators participated as a team at one of their staff meetings. It was a great opportunity to become familiar with the changes made to the Speech and Language Checklists.

In June we were notified that the room we utilized at Oakwood Elementary School for our before and after school program was being reclaimed by the school.

Fortunately we had an opportunity to move the program to St. John Bosco Elementary School where we have one exclusive room and one shared space room.

This allowed the centre to increase its enrollment.

ACW qualified for a one-time funding grant from Niagara Region Children's Services and the Early Childhood Development Centre to support the purchase of new play-based materials and equipment. The purpose of the grant was to support pedagogy and curriculum development in the centres consistent with How Does Learning Happen? Ontario's Pedagogy for the Early Years.

The Educators were very excited to receive new toys and equipment in order to enhance the programing being offered to the children.

ACW HEALTH & SAFETY UPDATE

In 2023, A Child's World was part of the WSIB Excellence Program once again. The Excellence program is a WSIB program in Ontario which helps companies manage a system for health and safety in the workplace. This is accomplished though mentoring, pooling of resources and sharing of best practices between members and the WSIB. Excellence program members can reduce their workplace injuries and illnesses and be rewarded with rebates on WSIB premiums. The two topics that A Child's World covered were Management Review and Health and Safety Objectives. By participating in this program, A Child's World will receive recognition from WSIB.

In 2023, A Child's World had no lost time cases from WSIB and Incidents, as well Medical Leaves decreased from 2022 within the organization.

Centre monthly inspections have been successfully completed with little to no corrective actions. Compliance packages were available on our staff portal for all Educators and Management to complete.

ACW's 11th Annual Health and Wellness Day was Thursday May 25, 2023.

Through The Foundation, money is raised to invest in our children and our Early Learning Environments. We continually strive to improve our services and recognize the need for upgrades to our programs.


Dollars raised through The Foundation are put directly into our child care centres.

FINANCIAL OPERATING RESULTS DECEMBER 31, 2023









